

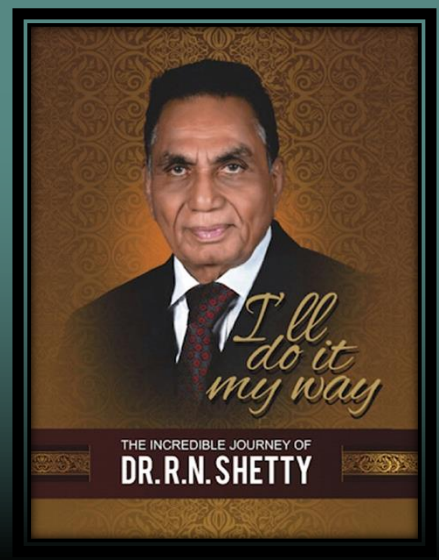

TALENT HUNT

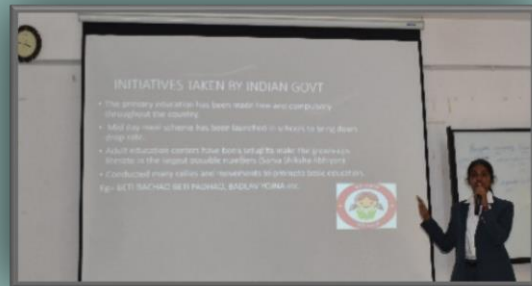


On 24th Sep' 2022 , First Year Degree students have participated in Talent Hunt Event. It has been done in 2 categories; Stage and Non- Stage programs.



WORLD LITERACY DAY

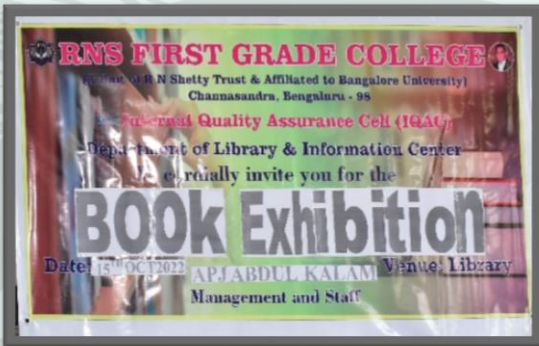
- Presentation by Students

CULTURAL INAUGURATION



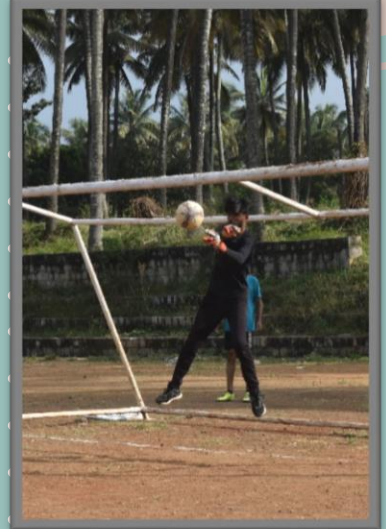

Nearly 80 teams from various streams took part in the exhibition.



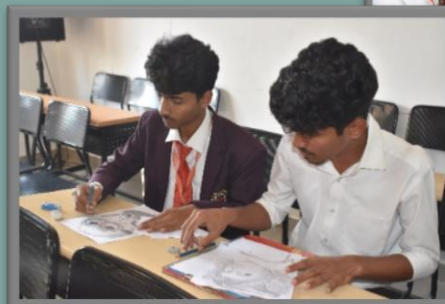
The models are done by using bio-degradable materials. The models are related to all subjects, Play Macbeth was also beautifully staged and other beneficial projects.



CULTURAL WEEK

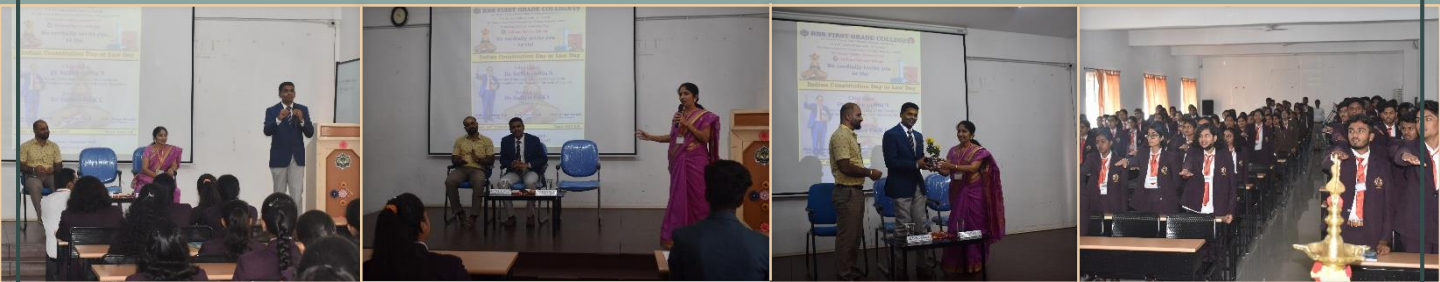


Every year there are cultural competitions, among which face painting, group dance, singing, pot making, nail art, rangoli and pencil sketch conducted to cherish students' inherent talent.

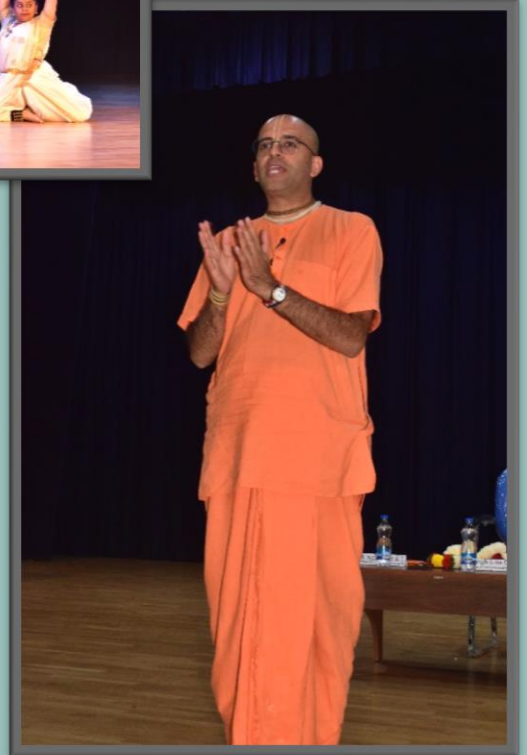
NATIONAL CONSUMERS' RIGHT DAY
