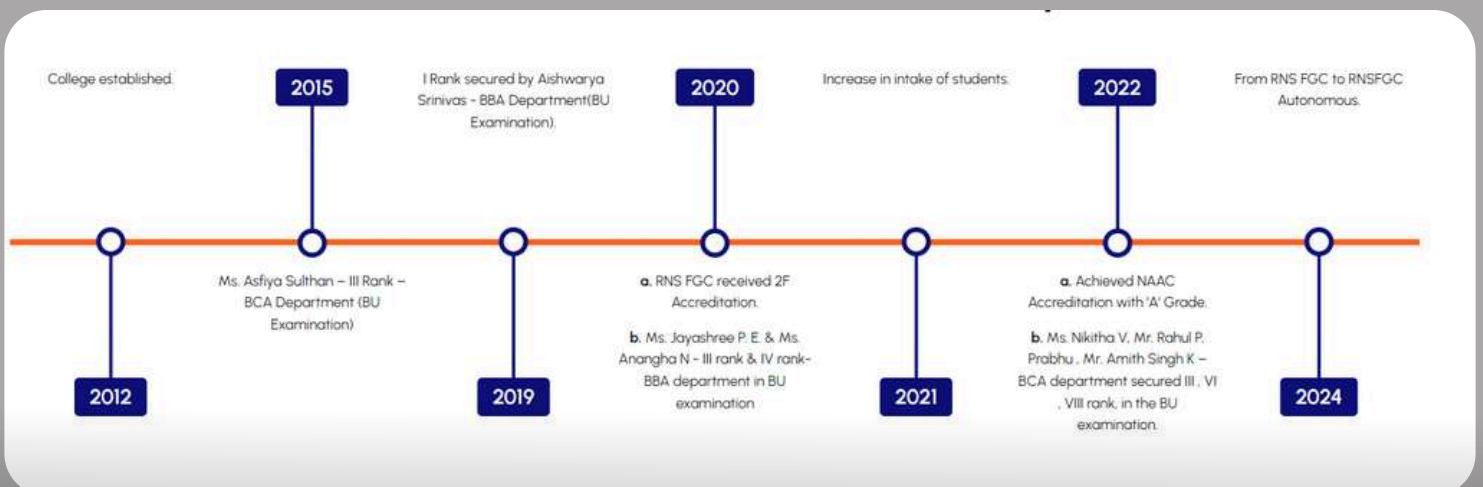

RNS First Grade College continues to enhance student employability through industry-oriented training programs and internship opportunities. The college facilitated internships with leading organizations such as Pentagon Space Pvt. Ltd. and Scontinent Technology, allowing students to gain practical exposure in IT and software development. Nine BCA students secured internships at Pentagon Space, while four others joined Scontinent Technology in full-stack development, AI/DS, and frontend roles. These initiatives help students bridge academic knowledge with real-world industry experience.

To further improve professional readiness, the college conducted a Campus Recruitment Training (CRT) program titled “Empowering Minds, Elevating Futures” in collaboration with SoW Moxie Services. 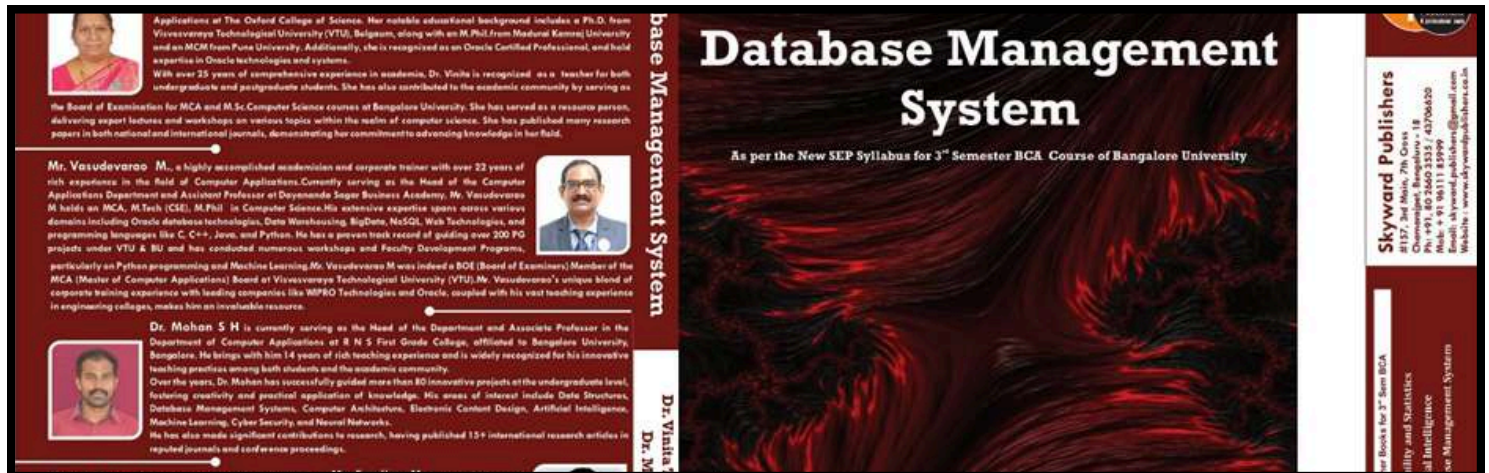

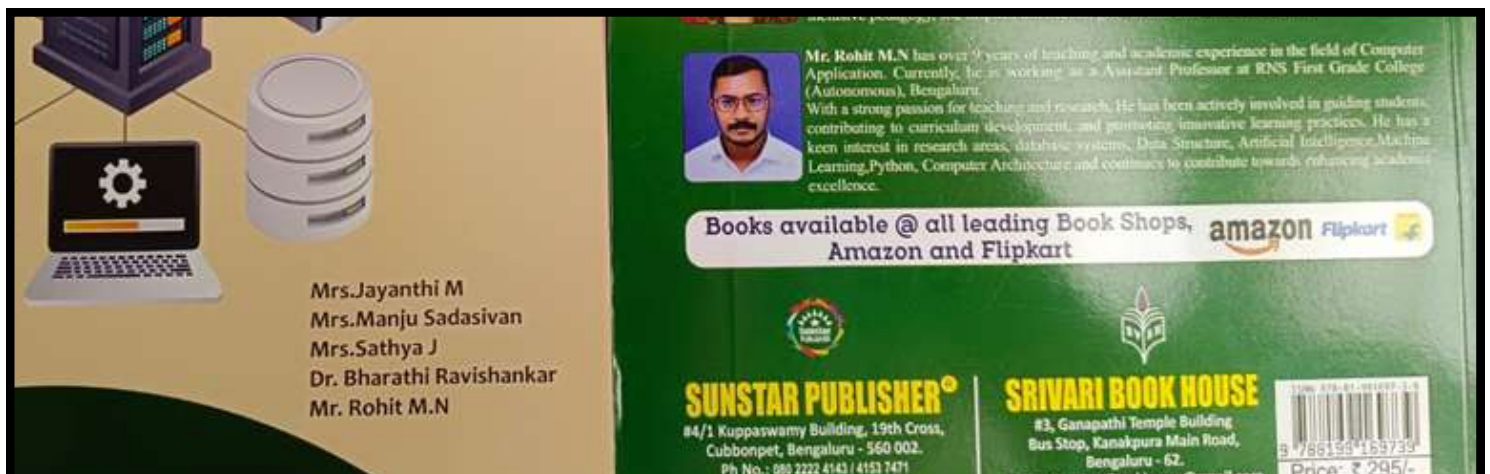
